Internship Requirements:

1. **Interns must turn in a plan outlining the sequence of FSU-Teach courses they intend to take through Apprentice Teaching and graduation. Please list the semester and year for each course on the back of this form. The FSU-Teach course listing can be found at <http://www.fsu-teach.fsu.edu/courses.php> and a suggested course sequence at <http://www.fsu-teach.fsu.edu/FSUTeachTeachingSeries.pdf>**
2. **Interns must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.**
3. **Interns must attend their FSU-Teach classes on any day for which they claim internship hours. It is not acceptable to be too sick for class, but well enough to intern the same day.**
4. **Only one semester in the plan may include an internship without an FSU-Teach class the same semester.**

FSU-Teach will attempt to match you with your first choice for internship site, but priority is given to students who have been in the program longer. If you are offered an internship, it may not be your first choice. You will be notified of your internship acceptance by email. If your internship site does not work out for any reason at any time during the semester, contact Robin Smith at smith@bio.fsu.edu immediately. You may try another internship if one is available.
